Also during the AFM, Hamilton and DreamAgo are presenting a panel entitled SO THEY'VE OPTIONED YOUR SCRIPT, THEY'VE DECIDED TO MAKE YOUR MOVIE.....NOW WHAT? on Monday 8th November from 5-6pm in the pressroom of the Loews Hotel. Sydney Levine( Founder of the unique acquisitions database Film Finders, specialist in International Sales, Marketing and Acquisitions and creator of SydneysBuzz) will be the moderator and among the confirmed panelists are distributor/ sales agent Mark Damon( Foresight Unlimited), casting director Ronnie Yeskel( Pulp Fiction, Curb your Enthusiasm , Atlas Shrugged), publicist Erik Bright( Little Miss Sunshine, Sideways, Crash) and Entertainment Lawyer Todd Stern( WWBCGE).
