



MELISSA LEO AND HAYDEN PANETTIERE GO “OVER THE WALL”

Indomina Releasing Handling Worldwide Sales at AFM

Los Angeles, CA – November 3, 2011 – It was announced today that Academy Award® winner Melissa Leo (“The Fighter,” “Frozen River” “21 Grams”) and Hayden Panettiere (“Heroes,” “Fireflies in the Garden”) will join Nick Stahl (“Terminator 3: Rise of the Machines,” “Sin City”) and Freddy Rodriguez (“Grindhouse,” “Planet Terror”) in *OVER THE WALL* – a dramatic thriller written and being directed by Steven Christopher Young, who is making his feature directorial debut with the film.

OVER THE WALL is being produced by Young with Larry Meistrich (“Sling Blade,” “You Can Count on Me”) and Ken H. Keller (“Jeremy Fink and the Meaning of Life,” “The Naked Brothers Band”). Executive producers are Steven Beer and Freddy Rodriguez.

Worldwide sales are being handled by Indomina Releasing - a division of The Indomina Group, the U.S. and Dominican Republic based producer and distributor of film, TV and trans-media content. Indomina is introducing the project to buyers at the American Film Market (AFM) in Santa Monica.

OVER THE WALL is a performance driven drama/thriller with crossover commercial appeal. A love story set in the world of professional stock car racing, it’s the tale of how one tragic event rips apart the lives and relationships of four closely intertwined people (husband, wife, surrogate mother and best friend) causing each of them to go to places and do things unimaginable to find redemption and to preserve the most sacred thing of all, true love.

Principal photography is slated to begin this spring in Ohio. The film will also shoot in North Carolina.

In addition to “**Over the Wall**,” Indomina’s international sales slate includes the stylish thriller “**The Bounty Hunter**,” the comedy “**A Fantastic Fear of Everything**” starring Simon Pegg (“Shaun of the Dead,” “Hot Fuzz”); the horror film “**Enter Nowhere**” (U.S. release through Lionsgate); the dramatic thriller “**Over the Wall**”; the horror feature “**The Shrine**” (U.S. theatrical release through IFC Films); and the award winning comedy “**Tiny Furniture**” (released by IFC in the U.S.).

The Indomina Group has been active of late, having recently optioned rights to the popular “Cabin Fever” franchise with plans to produce and distribute at least two more feature films.

The company also acquired North American distribution rights (as well as financing and selling) “A Fantastic Fear of Everything” as well as the thriller “Life Without Principle” – the newest film from

internationally acclaimed director/producer and contemporary maestro of Hong Kongese action cinema Johnnie To.

In July, Indomina announced a partnership with Samuel L. Jackson to produce a new live action "Afro Samurai" film based on the popular animated series that has spawned an impressive franchise and a global following. This highly anticipated film project is expected to come off the ground in 2012.

Indomina's critically-acclaimed epic adventure "Detective Dee and The Mystery of the Phantom Flame" directed by Tsui Hark is on the home stretch of a successful theatrical run that saw it earn the highest per-screen box office average of Labor Day holiday weekend in North America. Other recent releases include the romantic comedy "Griff the Invisible," starring Ryan Kwanten ("True Blood"), Yuen Woo Ping's martial arts feature "True Legend," starring Vincent Zhao, Zhou Xun, Michelle Yeoh and the late David Carradine, and Teddy Chan's award-winning "Bodyguards & Assassins."
